Road Safety:

It was brought to our attention that some of our older pupils have not been crossing the road safely before and after school. We have spoken to the children about this in school, but felt it was important to let parents know as well. If your child does come to school or go home on their own it is really important that you discuss road safety with them. Our first priority is the safety of the children, but we cannot keep them safe when they are not on the school site. With the Easter Holidays coming up children may be playing out and be near to main roads. Even the most sensible children need reminding about road safety!
