Dear Parents/Carers,

Covid Regulations and Isolation

Please note the following information regarding West Heath Primary School's procedure for isolation due to Coronavirus from school this term. We will constantly monitor Public Health England guidance and Department for Education guidance.

SYMPTOMS

- If your child has symptoms of Coronavirus, they must have a PCR test even if a Lateral Flow Test is negative.
- If your child's test is negative, they can return to school.
- If your child's test is positive they need to isolate for 10 days from the day that their symptoms started.
- Remote Learning will not be provided given the fact that your child is ill.

CLOSE CONTACT

- If your child has been identified as a close contact of someone who has Coronavirus they must have a PCR test before returning to school.
- If the PCR test is negative, they can return to school
- If the PCR test is positive they must isolate for 10 days.
- The purpose of a Lateral Flow Test is for asymptomatic cases, if your child has any symptoms at all, they must have a PCR test before returning to school.
- Remote Learning will be provided by your child's class teacher.

CLASS ISOLATION

- Classes will only be sent home to isolate if 10% of the class have tested positive for Coronavirus.
- Remote Learning will be provided by your child's class teacher.
